Welcome to the open house public meeting for the US 61 West Outer Extension, Phase 2A, Phase 2, and Phase 3 Projects. This meeting is to inform residents about the proposed projects, which are currently at the preliminary design level, and gather input regarding any issues that could impact the projects.

This is an open house informal meeting. Please review the available materials and feel free to ask questions. Representatives from the City of Wentzville and the design consultant are available to answer any questions that you may have regarding the current status of the projects.

It is important to note that these are preliminary plans and are subject to change.

PROJECT LOCATIONS

US 61 West Outer Road Extension Phase 2A:

Located along Wentzville Parkway from Meyer Road to Parkway Ridge Boulevard, approximately 0.41 miles long.

• Widen Wentzville Parkway from four to five lanes and replace/reconstruct existing pavement.

US 61 West Outer Road Extension Phase 2:

Located on the west side of US 61 from north of Timber Trace Crossing to Wentzville Parkway, 1.46 miles long.

Construct new outer road on the west side of US 61 and tie in at Wentzville Parkway.

US 61 West Outer Road Extension Phase 3:

Located on the west side of US 61 from Jockeys Run to north of Timber Trace Crossing, 0.40 miles long.

Construct new outer road on the west side of US 61 and connect to The Oaks at Lexington Subdivision.

What is the purpose of these projects?

- Improves safety.
- Serves as a reliever to the heavily traveled US 61.
- Satisfies a key component of the City's Transportation Master Plan to create a transportation link to the heart of the City from the community.
- Connects expanding residential areas to businesses.
- Provides economic development opportunities.

What has been completed thus far?

- Concept Studies
- Preliminary Plans and Cost Estimates (where we are at today)
- <u>Environmental Documentation</u> Ecological Resource Report, Section 106 approval with Phase 1 Report,
 Stream Impacts and Wetland Evaluation, Endangered Species Determination, Noise Studies, Preparations for National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Classification

What is the construction schedule?

US 61 West Outer Road Extension Phase 2A:

• City of Wentzville recently submitted a funding application to the St. Charles County Road Board for Phase 2A. Pending the outcome of obtaining funding this project could begin as early as Spring 2022.

US 61 West Outer Road Extension Phase 2:

• This phase is currently unfunded and is not shown on the City of Wentzville's five year capital improvement plan. The City will continue to explore funding opportunities such as the MoDOT Cost Share program and St. Charles County Road Board.

US 61 West Outer Road Extension Phase 3:

• This phase is currently unfunded and is not shown on the City of Wentzville's five year capital improvement plan. The City will continue to explore funding opportunities such as the MoDOT Cost Share program and St. Charles County Road Board.

What are the costs of these projects?

Phase 2A: \$2.4 million Phase 2: \$10.2 million Phase 3: \$4.0 million
