Candidate Filing Opens Dec. 5

Starting at 8 a.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 5, candidates may begin filing for the elected municipal offices that will appear on the April 2024 ballot. Candidates must file in person at City Hall, located at 1001 Schroeder Creek Blvd. The filing period will remain open until 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 26. This reflects a 2021 change to the state law regarding filing dates for candidates for elected office.

Positions open for filing include Mayor and one Alderman from each of the three Wards. There is a \$25 fee, due when filing. City ordinances state that candidates running for Mayor must be at least 25 years of age, a U.S. citizen; and a resident of the city at the time of and for at least one year next preceding the election. City ordinances state that candidates running for Alderman must be at least 18 years of age; a U.S. citizen; and an inhabitant and resident of the City for at least one year prior to the election. Candidates must also be a resident, at the time they file and during the time they serve, of the Ward from which they are elected.
