Golf Carts in Wentzville

The City urges caution in residential areas, especially with golf carts. For safety, please remember these Wentzville rules:

- Drive only on streets with a speed limit of 25 MPH or less, or when crossing streets with a 35 MPH limit.
- Drivers must be at least 16 years old and have a valid driver's license.
- Golf carts must have a parking brake, rearview mirror, VIN and seat belts for rear-facing seats.
- Do not drive golf carts on sidewalks, trails, paths or walkways unless designated.
- Golf carts cannot be driven at speeds exceeding 20 MPH.
- Golf carts must be equipped with lights and reflectors when operated during hours of darkness, including a front-facing headlamp and a rearfacing red lamp.

Unlock Grants for Your Downtown Business

Wentzville's Board of Aldermen is committed to preserving and improving Historic Downtown Wentzville. The Business Development and Facade Improvement grants help to stimulate property development, strengthen new and existing business, and facilitate the rehabilitation and modernization of downtown buildings — all while preserving their history and adding value to the Wentzville community.



Between Aug. 1 and Aug. 31, Historic Downtown businesses in Historic Downtown Wentzville can apply for a Facade Improvement or Business Development grant. Facade Improvement Grants

This program is open to businesses and mixed-use buildings more than 30 years old that are located in Wentzville's Historic Downtown zoning districts (HD-1, HD-2 or HD-3). Residential structures are not eligible. Facade Improvement Grants are a 50-50 match for an amount not to exceed \$10,000, per project. A total of \$30,000 has been set aside for 2024 grants.

Business Development Grants

This program is open to new* or significantly expanding businesses in Wentzville's Historic Downtown zoning districts (HD-1, HD-2, HD-3). The Business Development Grant is designed to ease start-up and/or business development costs. The grant can be used for various interior building improvements such as paint, finish carpentry, flooring or countertops. *New businesses must have been open for less than 12 months.

Please note: The Business Development and Facade Improvement grants cannot be used in combination.
