




# Economic Development Activity Map

### **FACADE IMPROVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM**

This program is open to businesses and mixed-use buildings more than 30 years old that are located in the HD-1, HD-2 or HD-3 zoning districts. The purpose of the Facade Grant Improvement program is to permit and encourage the preservation of historic structures and avoid general neighborhood deterioration through renovation and restoration.

## **BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT GRANT PROGRAM**

This program is open to new or significantly expanding businesses in Wentzville's Historic Downtown zoning districts (HD-1, HD-2 or HD-3). The Business Development Grant is designed to ease start-up and/or business development costs. The grant can be used for various interior building improvements such as paint, finish carpentry, flooring or countertops.
