

What year did your organization start? In 1970 Velma Brewer, a school nurse, became concerned about children without adequate coats and clothing. She started collecting and soon reached out for help. She asked her friends and family for clothing that their children outgrew to provide for those without. In 1971 the shop was operated by members of various area churches.

What is the mission of your organization? To serve the underserved in our community and surrounding area.

What projects are you currently working on? We are doing fundraising projects. All money raised will be used for building acquisition/expansions as well as charitable activities.


What's your favorite thing about Wentzville? The people of Wentzville are what make us a wonderful town and community.
