



Extra Patrol and Vacation Checks

Are you planning a summer vacation? If you plan to take a vacation for a few days, a week or longer, the Wentzville Police Department (WPD) can keep watch over your house while you relax on your trip. WPD provides vacation checks FREE of charge to residents within Wentzville city limits. Golf Carts in Wentzville

Please remember to drive safely in residential areas, especially when using golf carts. Thank you for helping to keep Wentzville safe. Here are the key rules for owning and operating a golf cart in Wentzville. Read the full ordinance at www.wentzvillemo.gov/GolfCarts.

- Golf carts are allowed on streets with a speed limit of 25 MPH or less, or when crossing streets with a speed limit of 35 MPH or less.
- Drivers must be at least 16 years old and hold a valid driver's license. •
- Golf carts must have a parking brake, rearview mirror, VIN number and seat belts for rear-facing seats. •
- Avoid driving golf carts on sidewalks, multi-use trails, paths or walkways unless designated. •
- The maximum speed limit for golf carts is 20 MPH.
- Use lights and reflectors, including a front-facing headlamp and rear-facing red lamp, when driving at night.
