Make Your Utility Tax Rebate Appointment Online

From April 1 through May 31, eligible residents can apply for a City utility-tax refund. Eligible residents should use one of these methods to apply for the rebate:

- **Email:** Send the required documentation to ContactUs@wentzvillemo.gov or submit an online application (beginning April 1).
- **Mail:** Send the required documentation to:
 - Utility Tax Rebate, City of Wentzville, 1001 Schroeder Creek Blvd., Wentzville, MO 63385
- **In-Person:** Schedule an appointment to apply at City Hall by calling (636) 639-2121 or making an appointment online.
- **Online:** Starting April 1, you can apply online at www.wentzvillemo.gov/TaxRebate.

Solid Waste Billing

Solid waste bills will begin arriving in mailboxes in late April. Solid waste bills are now separate from water/sewer bills, billed in three-month increments and come directly from Meridian Waste. Residents are encouraged to verify their account information to ensure it is accurate. You can do so by visiting www.MeridianWaste.com/Wentzville. Residents have several bill pay options, including:

- Mailing a check to Meridian Waste
- Paying by phone using a bank draft, credit or debit card
- Setting up autopay, which can be done online or by calling Meridian

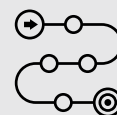


Parks Master Plan
